Two sisters, Susan Steinbach and Marilyn Schiveley, will relate their story of cleaning out the family home of 50+ years, and how they grew to know their deceased parents in a new way by going through their “stuff”. The sisters will talk about how they distributed treasured family items amongst siblings, cleared out a vintage California history book collection, compiled family history binders from letters and clippings found, held estate/garage sales, and worked with appraisers, liquidators, and contractors to clear the home and bring it to market.

They will pay particular attention to the pitfalls and pleasantries of such a process. The audience will come away with a sense of options for handling estate property in their family and what steps they might take to plan for, enhance and streamline the process.
