Interviewing: Before It's Too Late

As children, we don't often get to know our older relatives. But they provide a key view of those who have gone before. They are in a unique position to share firsthand information about our ancestors, and may remember important facts that might not have been recorded. A personal interview may be the best way to gather family history information. A census record will still be there in twenty years. It's important to make an effort to interview older relatives before it's too late. Ed Lucky, director of the Sacramento Family History Center, will guide us through the preparation and interview process.

Ed Lucky and his wife Linda Lucky have been Directors in Sacramento for several years. He has traced his family back 9 generations and taken "Cemetery" trips to England, Scotland, the Louisiana swamps, Utah and Idaho. He's a retired senior executive and golf professional and has done family history for nearly 30 years.
